The goals of the Beach Walk project are two fold. First, is to provide a direct and independent long term revenue source that will go directly to the football program and other student clubs and organizations at CBJSHS. The second is making needed physical improvements to the facilities at Minutemen Stadium. Extensive improvements can already be seen with the addition of the paver sidewalks, irrigation systems, custom curbing, and beautiful landscaping, and the special Memorial Walk in the stadium that pays tribute to the graduates killed in the line of duty. The Beach Walk is a work-in-progress, and will take several years to complete, and when finished the entire stadium facility will be one of the most beautiful and prestigious school stadiums in Brevard county.

Revenues are generated by selling engraving space on brick pavers. The cost of these pavers is \$50.00 for a 4" x 8", \$100.00 for an 8" x 8", and \$250.00 for the large 12" x 12". Special orders for size and type can also be done easily.
